

Annex 7 of Work Instruction No. T-U.29.0299.0050 AF**LIFTING MACHINE PRIVILEGES AND KEY RELEASE**

The ignition keys of lifting machines that can be handed over to external companies are properly identified. The key tag bears the identification of the respective lifting machine, and on the reverse side the operator authorization code required to operate the lifting machine.

The external partner indicates in advance to the contact person what kind of lifting machine would be needed for his work.

If necessary, the contact person indicates in advance, in a documented manner, to the lifting machine administrator when and what kind of lifting machine needs to be issued.

Contact is pre -documented to the security service, which lifting machine can be expected.

Upon arrival at the site, the external partner coordinates with the Security Service: the external partner selects the necessary lifting machine and presents to the Security Service the document certifying the lifting machine operator's authorization.

The security service compares the operator's authority with the code on the key tag of the lifting machine operator's authority code required to operate a lifting machine.

If the code matches, the security service will issue a documented key to the lifting machine to the outside company.

Lifting machinery may only be used in accordance with the Lifting Machine Safety Regulations (GM Regulation 47/1999) and the instructions for use of lifting machinery. It is forbidden to give the startup key to unauthorized persons.

If the code does not match, the Security Service will refuse to issue the key and notify the Contact Person.
